Category	Popular spending items that make up that category
National Defense	Department of defense-military, atomic energy defense activities, defense-related activities
International Affairs	International security assistance, conduct of foreign affairs, foreign information and exchange activities
Science, Space, Technology	General science and basic research; space flight, research, and supporting activities
Energy	Energy supply, conservation, emergency preparedness, energy information, policy and regulation
Natural Resources and Environment	Water resources, conservation and land management, recreational resources, pollution control
Agriculture	Farm income stabilization, agricultural research and services
Commerce and housing credit	Mortgage credit, postal service, deposit insurance, other advancement of commerce
Transportation	Ground, air, water and other transportation
Community and regional development	Community development, area and regional development, disaster relief and insurance
Education, training, and social services	Elementary, secondary, and vocational education, higher education, research and general education aids
Health	Health care services, health research and training, consumer and occupational health and safety
Income Security	General and federal employee retirement and disability insurance, unemployment compensation, housing assistance, food and nutrition assistance, other income security
Veterans Benefits and Services	Income security for veterans, education, housing, training, and rehabilitation, hospital and medical care
Administration of Justice	Federal law enforcement activities, litigative and judicial activities, federal correctional activities
General Government	Legislative functions, executive direction and management, central fiscal operations, personnel management
Net Interest	Interest on treasury debt securities, interest received by on and off-budget trust funds, other interest
Undistributed offsetting receipts	Employer share, employee retirement, employer share, employee retirement, rents and royalties on the OCS
